## Office Order No.13

Sub: Preventive measures to contain the spread of COVID-19

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In the Office Order No. 04 dated 20.05.2020 measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 and instructions on regulation of attendance of the staff members were issued. Further, it is noticed that the number of COVID-19 positive cases are increasing rapidly in Telangana state and GHMC area in particular where the IA&AD offices are located. Many officials in various Central Government Ministries/Departments have been tested COVID-19 positive. It has been reported that some of the staff members of this office and other sister offices located in this complex have also been tested COVID-19 positive. Therefore, the responsibilities to protect ourselves and each and every official have thus become imperative to prevent further from spread of disease.

In order to contain the spread of COVID-19, it has been proposed that the entire offices of the PAG (A&E) Andhra Pradesh and AG (A&E) Telangana shall remain closed from 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020 to 5<sup>th</sup> July 2020 to undertake thorough disinfection of the entire blocks of both A&E offices (A, E & F Blocks.)

The following additional instructions are hereby issued for strict compliance of the staff members:

- Any official with a mild cold/cough/fever or flu-like symptoms needs to stay at home under intimation to their Controlling Officer.
- Officers/Staff residing in containment zone shall not attend office and shall continue to work from home until containment zone is de-notified.
- iii. Face mask has to be worn at all times inside the office premises. Administrative action will be initiated against such officials if found without wearing a mask.
- iv. Face to face meetings/discussions/interactions may completely be avoided and minimum social distancing shall be maintained.

- All the officers and officials are instructed to be available on telephone and electronic means of communication at all times.
- vi. The officials, who have been tested COVID\_19 positive, are instructed to remain in self home quarantine for 14 days w.e.f. his/her last day of attendance in the office and shall furnish a copy of test report to this office.
- vii. The officials who came into direct contact with the affected persons shall undergo self home quarantine compulsorily as per Ministry of Health & Family Welfare guidelines dated 04.06.2020 and closely monitor their health for 14 days. These officials shall undergo testing as per ICMR protocol.
- viii. The other officers/officials, who were in indirect contact with the affected persons, shall monitor their health closely. In case they develop any of the symptoms of COVID-19 as notified by M/o Health, they shall also undergo COVID 19 tests and shall inform this office from time to time.

All other the instructions issued vide Office Order No.4 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 shall remain in force until further orders.

The office will resume functioning from 06.07.2020 onwards.
